

# SCHOOL SUPPLIES for K - HS

## No Trapper Keepers for Grades K - 8



**KINDERGARTEN:** Please use a permanent marker to write your child's name on the following items:

1. An old short sleeve button shirt (dad's) for a paint shirt. No t-shirts please.
2. A large beach or bath towel for rest time.
3. A folder with pockets.
4. A backpack large enough to hold lunch container, folders **and** papers.
5. Colors, paper, construction paper, pencils, scissors, erasers, etc. are **provided by the school** - so the students use similar tools.

**FIRST GRADE:** (Miss Medendorp)

1. 4 boxes of 24 count crayons (No glitter crayons please. They smear when laminated.)
2. 1 box of 8 washable makers - Crayola bold tip classic colors.
3. 2 large glue sticks - prefer UHU - goes on purple, dries clear.
4. 1 folder with pockets.
5. One 12 inch plastic standard ruler.
6. A dozen pencils and one large eraser (Pink Pearl brand is the best).
7. 1 flip top, plastic box – approximately 8" x 5" x 2" - NOT LONGER, PLEASE!
8. A backpack large enough to hold lunch container, folders **and** papers.  
(**NO** rolling backpacks please - we will not have enough space for all of them in the classroom.)
9. A paint shirt (button front, short sleeve)

**FIRST GRADE:** (Mrs. Ter Horst)

1. 4 boxes of 24 count crayons
2. A dozen pencils and one large eraser (Pink Pearl brand is the best).
3. 1 folder with pockets.
4. One 12 inch plastic standard ruler.
5. 4 glue sticks - **Large-size**
6. 1 bottle of **white** glue (no blue gel glue!)
7. Scissors (Fiskars preferred)
8. A box to hold supplies - it must fit **inside** the desk!
9. A paint shirt (button front, short sleeve)
10. A backpack large enough to hold lunch container, folders **and** papers.
11. A box of tissues

**SECOND GRADE:** (Mrs. Eagan)

1. A box of crayons
2. A box of 8 washable markers - Classic colors, bold tip
3. 2 folders with pockets
4. 2 glue sticks - **Large-size**
5. 1 bottle of **white** glue (no blue gel glue!)
6. Scissors
7. Old sock - to be used as a whiteboard eraser
8. 2 Spiral bound notebooks - **wide rule** single subject
9. A box to hold supplies - it must fit inside the desk!

**SECOND / THIRD GRADE:** (Mr. Vos)

1. A box of crayons
2. A box of 8 washable markers - Classic colors, bold tip
3. 2 folders with pockets
4. 2 glue sticks - **Large-size**
5. 1 bottle of **white** glue (no blue gel glue!)
6. Scissors
7. Old sock - to be used as a whiteboard eraser
8. 2 Spiral bound notebooks - **wide rule** single subject
9. A box to hold supplies - it must fit inside the desk!
10. A paint shirt (button front, short sleeve)
11. A backpack large enough to hold lunch container, folders **and** papers.
12. A box of tissues
13. A dozen pencils

**THIRD GRADE:** (Miss Termaat)

1. A large eraser - good quality rubber eraser, cute ones just smear
2. A box of crayons
3. A set of washable markers
4. Scissors
5. A large glue stick
6. A big box of tissues
7. 1 Spiral notebook
8. Backpack

**FOURTH GRADE:** (Mrs. Memmelaar)

1. N.I.V. Bible (both OT & NT) – Students must have the **NIV** and **not** the NIRV or NIV Study Bible
2. 3 folders with pockets.
3. 1 spiral notebook
4. Markers, crayons, 2 dozen pencils (NO mechanical pump pencils)
5. Large glue stick
6. Big eraser - good quality (cute ones just smear)
7. Small personal pencil sharpener - be sure it can store the shavings
8. Scissors
9. 12-inch ruler with **both** inches and metric
10. Calculator
11. Box to hold supplies - it must fit inside the desk!
12. Box of tissues
13. NO TRAPPER KEEPERS!!

**FIFTH GRADE:** (Mr. Lapka)

1. 1 **5-subject** spiral notebook
2. 3 **individual** plain color folders (with pockets)
3. **N.I.V.** Bible (not Children's Bible!)

4. 1 large glue stick
5. Scissors
6. 1 dozen pencils and erasers (no mechanical pump pencils)
7. Small personal pencil sharpener - be sure it can store the shavings
8. 2 pens - 1 red & 1 blue (**NO Gel pens or White-out pens!**)
9. Markers and crayons
10. Linear **and** metric ruler
11. Calculator
12. Box of tissues
13. A box to hold supplies, it must fit inside the desk!
14. **NO TRAPPER KEEPERS!!**



### **FIFTH GRADE:** (Mr. Koelewyn)

1. N.I.V. Bible (both OT & NT) NIV - [Large Print / student version]
2. 5 folders with pockets
3. 5 spiral notebooks
4. Makers, crayons and two dozen pencils
5. Glue stick
6. Big erasers - good quality rubber eraser, cute ones just smear
7. Scissors
8. Ruler with **both** inches and metric
9. Calculator - battery operated preferred
10. Small personal pencil sharpener - be sure it can store the shavings
11. 2 plastic pocket folders, each a different color (preferably red and green)
12. One black dry erase pen
13. **NO TRAPPER KEEPERS!!**

### **JUNIOR HIGH SUPPLY LIST:**

1. NIV Bible (Study Bible)
2. 1 3-ring binder with dividers for different subjects with College-ruled filler paper
3. Graph paper recommended for math class (1/4")
4. 3 - two pocket folders with clasps
5. 1 plastic pouch to hold pens, pencils: **2 pens** (1 red, 1 blue) and **2 dozen pencils** and **8 colored pencil set**
6. 1 ten color pack of gel (or similar) pens - fine or medium point
7. 1 four-color pack of highlighters
8. 1 pack of Crayola markers - classic colors
9. 1 eraser, scissor, glue stick
10. White out **tape only** (no correction pens)
11. 1 pack of ruled note cards (any size - colored cards ok, just not neon colors please  
\*\* these are not needed until research paper time.
12. 1 calculator (suggested TI 30)
13. 1 USB flash drive (1 GB minimum) that can be taken home. - \$10 fee if one is not brought to school
14. Additional ½ " binder for **6<sup>th</sup> graders only**

**7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE ART SUPPLIES** - Sketch Book - at least 9 x 12 (if taking art)

**8<sup>th</sup> graders** taking Algebra 1 need to check High School Mathematics supply.
