

Calvin Christian Junior High After School Care

FAQ

Q: Is pre-registration required and does my student have to attend after school care?

A: Any junior high student that is not picked up by an adult by the 3:10 bell, must report to after school care. After school care is a walk-in service and does not require registration.

Q: Is after school care open if no students report to after care?

A: No. After school care is a walk-in service and is only open as needed. If the last student in after care is picked up at 4:00 p.m., the aftercare will close at 4:10 p.m.

Q: Can my student report to after school care at the end of sports, music or club meetings?

A: Parents are expected to pick up their students from all extracurricular activities. If you know you will need assistance please notify the coach, school office or the After School Care Supervisor so appropriate arrangements can be made. Communication is key to your student's safety.

Q: Can my student sign themselves out of after school care.

A: Students must be signed out by an adult. No exceptions.

Q: Are snacks provided?

A: No. We strongly encourage students to bring a snack and refillable water bottle to school.

Q: Will after school care be provided on half days?

A: After school care is only available on full school days. Half days are a great opportunity for class parents to communicate with other families to support each other. Calvin families are the best!

Q: Will my student's time in after school care be structured?

A: Yes. A typical afternoon is:

- *Free Time 3:10-3:30*
- *Homework Hour 3:30-4:30 (Chromebook can be used for homework only. No gaming allowed during homework hour.)*
- *Open Time 4:30-6:00*

Q: How much does after school care cost?

A: \$2.50 per 30 minutes for 1 child; \$3.50 per 30 minutes for 2 children; \$5.00 per 30 minutes for 3 or more children in the same household.
