- **Colleges will sometimes still accept students who have not met all the requirements.** Often these students will be required to take part in an academic support program or to make up the deficiency during the freshman year.
- Taking more courses in a subject area can reduce the number of courses required in college. For example, Dordt College recommends 2 years of foreign language for admission, but a student with 3 years of high school Spanish won't have to take any foreign language in college.
